MEMORANDUM

RE: Operation of Squaw Creek Water District Repair of Outlet at Sage Hen Reservoir.

I met with the Squaw Creek Irrigation Company Board (owners of Sage Hen Dam) at the Sweet Gas Station on April 16th. The Board wanted to discuss the problems associated with live flow water users on the creek diverting storage water when they are not company share holders. I told them that proper measurement and documentation of storage vs. natural flows must be kept by the watermaster so that turn-offs of natural flow diversions can be enforced. They stated, that when natural flows failed to fill the senior Westside-Sweet Ditch rights (approx. 640") they switched to storage water. This is the last ditch diversion on the creek and has a weir for measurement. They indicated, at that point there was minimal inflow from tributaries above. The watermaster adjusts storage flows to maintain the minimal flow past the Westside diversion. They felt there was no need to measure storage flows at the Sage Hen outlet. I stated, whatever they can make work is fine, but if the Department is called in because of problems, we will implement our policies concerning measurement/management.

I emphasized, I had evaluated the weir at the outlet and referenced my previous letter of 11/10/1994. I suggested, they may want to install a gauge on the reservoir to read storage levels. Although weak, they would could calculate an average outlet flow using storage reading decreases over time and also document storage used/remaining. I told them, I would be glad to survey and mark the reservoir elevations.

The Board has made an agreement with Bill Statton of the BOR Maintenance @ Black Canyon Dam. He has looked at the Sage Hen outlet, and suggested that liquid steel be used to coat the outlet elbow area. He has utilized this on bureau projects, and will supervise the repair. They indicated, they had looked at several other options. Several contractors stated, that a new liner would be difficult to install with the many elbows, and they would question if the welding would hold from the high water velocities and possible cavitation/vibration.

I emphasized this repair needed to be completed, and that major damage could result if outlet releases began to eat through the concrete outlet walls. They agreed, and plan to go ahead this fall. I told them to keep the Department informed of their plans and work schedule. They assured me they would.
