Dear Jerry:

As Watermaster for Water District No. 65, I would like to suggest certain modifications to our current system of procedures for ordering water flows from Cascade and Deadwood Reservoirs. In the future, I am asking all water users to order stored flows by 8:00 a.m. each day. The water orders will then be forwarded to the dam operators at Black Canyon Dam shortly after the 8:00 a.m. deadline. All water orders, whether they are for irrigation flows, flow augmentation for endangered salmon, or flood control purposes, will be required to come to my office before they are released. Simply stated, Watermaster control over releases from these reservoirs is critical to the success and accuracy of accounting for the delivery of storage water by the Water District.

Your cooperation on this issue is greatly appreciated by the District. If you have any questions with regard to this procedure, please give me a call here at the Payette office.
