Dear Water User:

I am in the process of finalizing the 1995 assessment billing, and it has come to my attention that you still owe your 1995 Water District assessment of \$.50 per acre. If there is a problem with the accuracy of your assessment, such as the acres are incorrect, please recompute the assessment due by changing the number of acres you are operating. The figures I originally used for calculating your assessment were based on the number of acres filed on for your water right, and if there is a discrepancy in those acres, the information at the Idaho Department of Water Resources should be corrected.

According to Idaho Code, you should not be allowed to divert water until this assessment is paid; however, since this is the first year the Water District has assessed for operational expenses. I have determined that we will work with all water users on the Payette River throughout this year to accomplish the collection of this assessment.

NOTICE OF STORAGE WATER CHARGED

Dear Water User:

According to the program used to account for deliveries on the Payette River, it has come to my attention that your water right has been cut, and that you are currently being charged for storage water from the Water District No. 65 rental pool. Please note that you must make arrangements with me as soon as possible to secure adequate storage water supplies as may be necessary for you to continue to use water from the Payette River this season.

The Water District No. 65 rental pool was formed to ensure the availability of storage water to users, such as yourselves, to allow for the season-long use of water from the Payette River system, even after a user's water right has been cut due to a lack of natural flow in the river. The cost of rental water from the rental pool has been set at a reasonable \$2.70 per acre foot (approximately equal to a .5 cfs diversion for a 24 hour period) for in basin use. At this time, it appears there will be enough storage water available through the rental pool to meet the needs of all users on the Payette.

Also, I have enclosed another Idaho Power consent form for you to sign and mail back to me. This form must be in my office no later than November 1, 1995, to ensure that your use for the 1995 season is computed accurately. If you have already sent me this form, please disregard this request.

Please contact me at your earliest convenience, as the season is coming to a close rather quickly. I look forward to visiting with you in the near future.
