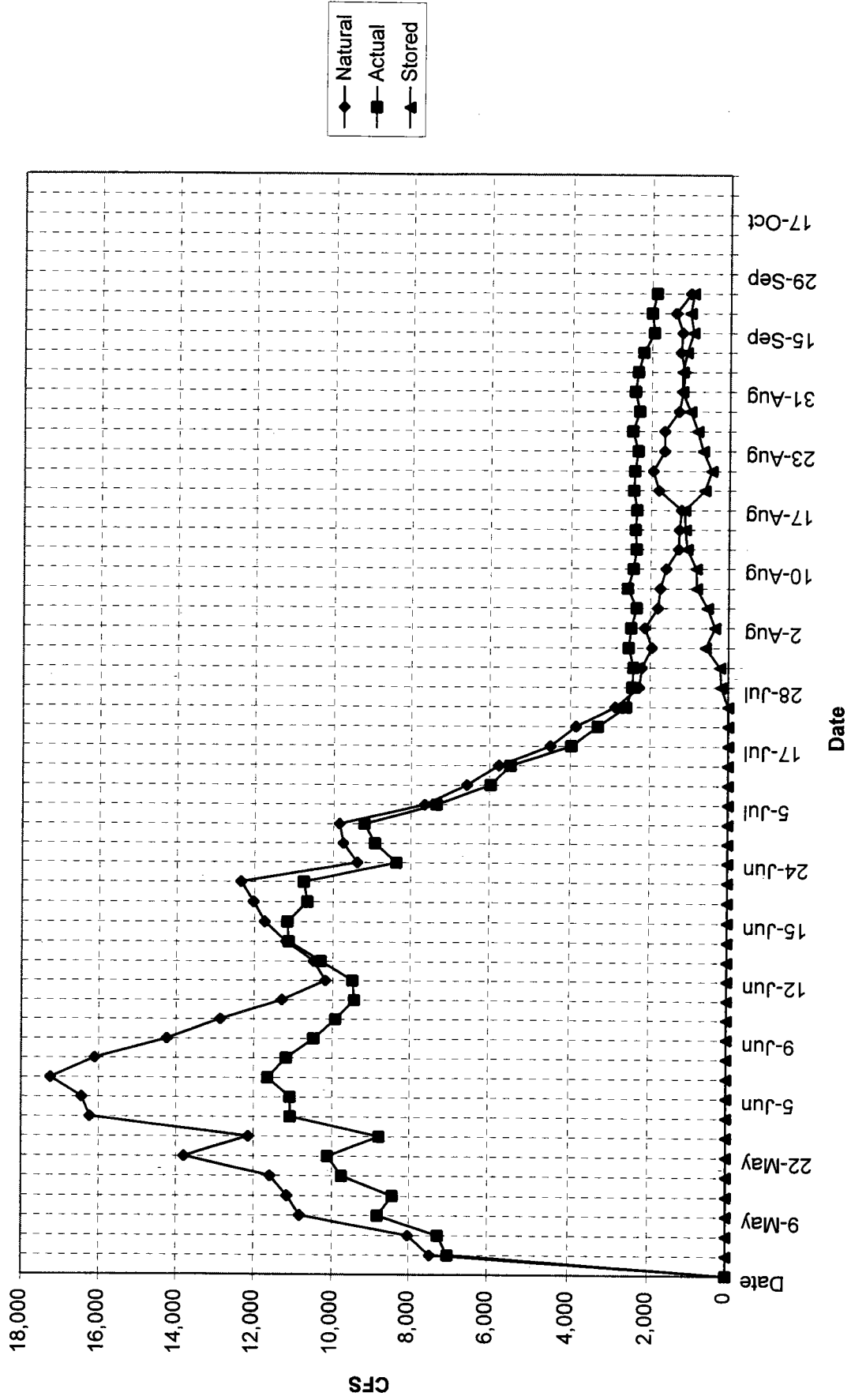

## Introduction

An important issue facing water users and water providers is the competition for water to meet all needs. This issue is of great concern, as urban and agricultural water users and environmental interests seek water supplies of sufficient quantity and quality to meet these competing demands from what is a limited and variable resource. A critical aspect of this quest for adequate water supplies is the issue of water conservation, particularly in irrigated agriculture.

A **Water Management Seminar**, to be held in Sacramento, California, on October 5-7, 1995, will address the issue of irrigation water conservation in a multi-disciplinary forum. The Seminar will be sponsored by USCID and the Bureau of Reclamation. Several important water organizations will be Cooperating Organizations. The Seminar was planned and organized by the USCID Committee on **Competing Interests in Water Resources**, chaired by Herbert W. Greydanus.

The objective of the seminar is to improve understanding of the opportunities and limitations of irrigation water conservation among water suppliers and users and environmental interest groups in order to advance conservation where appropriate and to look to other solutions where conservation is not an adequate course of action.

The theme of the Seminar is *Irrigation Water Conservation – Opportunities and Limitations*. Panel members and speakers will focus on the following topics: **Conservation Practices – Concepts and Misconceptions; Benefits and Detriments of Irrigation Water Conservation; Institutional Improvements for Water Conservation; and Case Histories of Irrigation Water Conservation.**

Prominent speakers will review and discuss key water conservation issues during the **Keynote Address** and in lunch and dinner presentations. A **Concluding Session**, featuring panel presentations and a discussion period involving seminar participants, will focus on future actions to be taken by USCID and the water community.

The Seminar will include a day-long **Study Tour** on Saturday to review water conservation and water management activities in the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta.

USCID will publish a **Seminar Proceedings** following the Meeting. Each registered participant will receive a copy of the Proceedings.

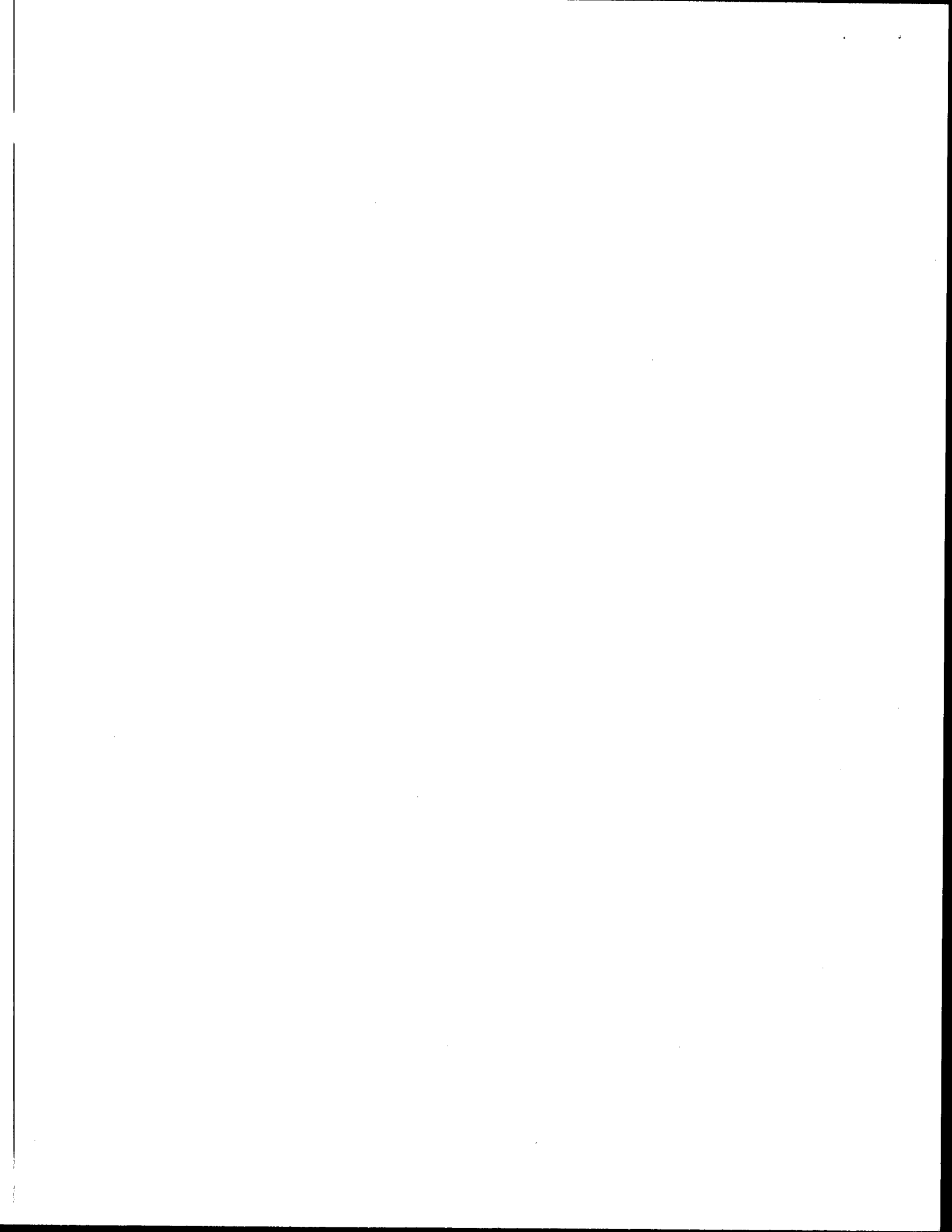
