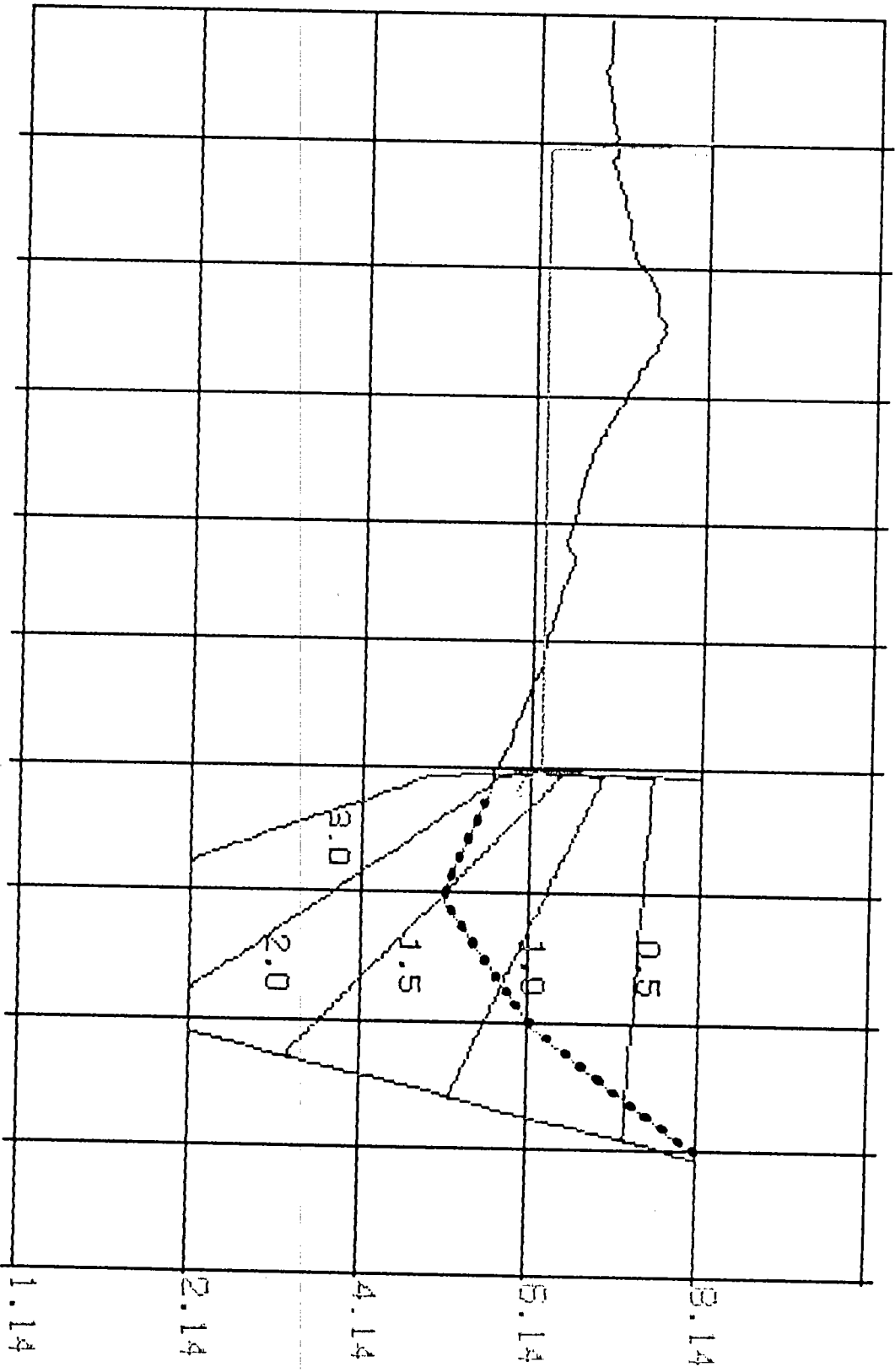
Reservoir storage is 128% of average for the date and 104% of the storage on this date last year. The 1996 runoff forecasts are 107% of average at Horseshoe Bend, 102% of average at Cascade Reservoir, and 110% of average at Deadwood Reservoir.

The Cascade Reservoir release is expected to remain at powerplant capacity of about 2,200 cfs for the next several weeks and then adjusted as necessary to conform to the flood control rule curves. The operation will be similar to last year except that lower releases are projected in May and June since we have more space in the reservoir now compared to last year and a lower runoff volume is forecast compared to 1995. The Deadwood release will be maintained at about 300 cfs for the next several weeks and adjusted as necessary to conform to the rule curves.

Cascade and Deadwood reservoirs are expected to fill in mid to late June.
