When Mr. Olson was Watermaster before, each summer was one on
contention for the following reasons.

1. Denying Share Holders use of water rights.

NA a. By not providing schedule of turns for the year, or even on a rotation
cycle. Thus losing 3 or 4 days per rotation.

NA b. Allowing user some possession of other users shares without
consent(excess water and unused turns).

NA 2. Did not have adjudicated decreed, permits, court order, or licensed rights
in possession while administering W/M duties.

NA 3. Without District consent performing W/M duties outside allotted time of
April 1 to Nov. 1.

4. Submitted no yearly reports to IDWR any years he was W/M.


* 5. Has hooked onto Bar Zee Stream pipeline and uses water off of it without
owning any shares of said stream.

NA 6. Uses the position of Watermaster for excessive travel on private land that
is not within the scope of the job.

For legal purposes I am requesting a copy of any response issued to Mr. Olson. Before the regular water season opens, I along with other concerned water users will be submitting a request for a State representative to meet with our water district to clarify the responsibilities of a Water master; in an attempt to avoid any further abuse of the system and need for legal action .
