Last year's chairman Daniel Mickelson called the meeting to order. ~~The~~ minutes of last year's meeting were read and approved by a motion from Glenn and a second from Roger. Motion carried. Frank moved we suspend the rules and retain the present chairman, secretary, and watermaster. Roger seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Membership of the advisory board was discussed. Glenn moved that Daniel represent the Rasmussen Ditch, Frank the Mickelson Ditch and DeWayne the Mendenhall Ditch. Roger seconded the motion. Motion carried.
