RE: NOTICE OF CONFERENCE - PETITIONS FOR DELIVERY OF GROUND WATER WITHIN WATER DISTRICT 13T, BANCROFT-LUND AREA

Dear District 13T Wateruser:

On March 11, 1996, Warren P. Lloyd and David Lloyd filed Petitions for Delivery Call (petitions) with the Department of Water Resources (department) seeking the delivery of water rights by priority within Water District 13T. On March 18, 1996, Paul N. Christensen filed a similar petition with the department. The petitioners state that they are in a position to accept mitigation from junior-priority ground water right holders. The oldest water right of the petitioners is in the name of Keith Lloyd and has a priority of August 8, 1962. The petitions potentially affect ground water rights with priorities later than August 8, 1962.

The department is required to treat the petitions as a potential contested case under the Administrative Procedures Act, since the petitions may result in the issuance of an order by the department.

Hence, the department will consolidate the three (3) petitions into one (1) proceeding and has scheduled a conference to seek informal resolution of the matter as provided in Section 67-5241, Idaho Code, IDAPA Rule 37.03.11.03003 (Conjunctive Management Rule 30.03) and the procedural and substantive rules of the department. A formal record of the conference will not be preserved. If the conference does not resolve the matter, the department will proceed in accordance with Conjunctive Management Rule 40, will schedule and conduct a formal hearing as needed and will subsequently issue an order in the contested case.

Matters to be discussed at the conference include but are not limited to the following:

- Reasons for the filing of the petitions including determination of issues and admissions of fact.
- Potential solutions to the alleged problem including acceptable and offered mitigation, if any.
- Available resource data and/or data which needs to be collected.

- Procedures to determine whether material injury is occurring.
- Hearing procedure and potential hearing dates if a hearing is required.

The department has scheduled the informal conference in this matter as follows:

Date: May 16, 1996 **Time:** 1:00 p.m.

Place: American Legion Hall, Grace Idaho

Notice of this conference and copies of the petitions are being provided to all water users in Water District 13T who have priorities of water use junior to the petitioners.

The conference will be conducted in a facility which meets the accessibility requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act. If you require special accommodations in order to attend, participate in or understand the conference, please advise the department within ten (10) days prior to the conference.

Notice is hereby given that a pre-hearing conference regarding the above-titled matter will be held in the auditorium of Minidoka County High School, 300 W. Highway 25, Rupert, Idaho, beginning at 6:00 p.m., Wednesday, November 16, 1994. The presiding officer at the conference will be R. Keith Higginson, Director.

The conference will be conducted in a facility which meets the accessibility requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act. If you require special accommodations in order to attend, participate in or understand the conference, please advise the department at least ten (10) days prior to the conference.

Notice is further given that the Department received 200 responses to the original Notice of Petition, Docket No. 37-03-11-1, which was sent to approximately 7200 holders of water rights to divert ground water from the Eastern Snake Plain Aquifer with priorities later-in-time than September 9, 1948, the priority date claimed by the A&B Irrigation District. A list of Respondents and potential Intervenors (late responses) is contained in the service list attached to this notice. Several of the responses were made on behalf of groups of ground water users, some of which identified members of the group and some for which the individual members are not presently identified.

The 200 representatives or individuals who have responded are now invited to participate in a pre-hearing conference. While the meeting will be open to the public, space limitations and good order will make it necessary to limit participation in the conference to the Department, the petitioner and those who are listed as respondents.

The matter of the petition will be reviewed informally using the following agenda:

1. Welcome and Introduction

2. Purpose of Meeting

• To discuss the process to be followed in addressing the issues raised by the petition. We will not hear testimony or opinion on the merits of the petition or any argument or defenses against applicability of the petition to any party at this pre-hearing conference.

3. Description of respondents

4. Status of conjunctive management rules

- Temporary rules extended until October 10
- Final rules adopted effective October 7

5. Provisions of rules applicable to the petition

- Petition is a delivery call by a senior-priority right holder against junior-priority ground water rights.
- The Eastern Snake Plain Aquifer is an area of the state in which ground water rights have not been incorporated into an existing water district (Rule 30).
- Ground water rights have not been adjudicated and there is no interim court order which can be used as the basis for creation of a water district (Rules 30.07 and 30.08).
- The delivery call is within an area already designated as having a common ground water supply (Rule 50). It is that area identified by the USGS on maps included in Professional Paper 1408-F excluding areas south of the Snake River and west of the line separating Section 34 and 35, T10S, R20E.

6. Options available:

<u>Informal resolution</u> - Parties may agree to an interim or permanent solution without a formal contested case hearing. (The pre-hearing conference is part of the informal process) (Rule 30.03).

Contested Case - We will need to establish a hearing schedule and discuss such matters as order of procedure -burden of proof - discovery - exchange of exhibits - stipulations - how to accommodate the large number of respondents.

Adjudication - Completion of the adjudication is necessary before expanding an existing water district or creating a new water district.

Order cessation of pumping - Rule 30.07g - By summary order the Director may prohibit or limit withdrawals taking into effect the existence of any approved mitigation plan.

Designate a ground water management area - Rule 30.07h - If it appears that the water supply is insufficient to meet the demands of all those having rights or if current withdrawals exceed the reasonably anticipated average rate of future natural recharge of the aquifer (RAARFNR).

<u>Potential new legislation</u> - Need has been expressed for ground water pumpers to be represented through some aquifer-wide organization.

7. Discussion

If any agreement is reached between the petitioner and respondents at this conference or a continuation thereof, such agreement will be reduced to writing and will be included in an order issued by the Director. If no agreement is reached, a tentative schedule for contested-case proceedings will be discussed and will be set forth in a further order from the Director.

The Director will not hear or act on any motions at this conference but will accept written motions for future consideration and action. Motions which appear appropriate at this time are:

- Motion to consider the matter under the final rules for conjunctive management adopted October 7, 1994. This could result in exclusion of some ground water users who received the original notice but whose wells are located south of the Snake River and west of the line separating Section 34 and 35 T10S R20E.
- Motion to allow late respondents to intervene in the proceeding.

 Motion to allow augmentation of responses which identified ground water pumper groups but which did not provide the names of individual water right holders represented.

Several of the responses to the Notice of Petition included motions requesting various actions which will be acted on following the pre-hearing conference.




