### MEMORANDUM

**TO:** WATERUSERS IN WATER DISTRICT 13T  
(PARTS OF BASINS 13 AND 29)

**SUBJECT:** PETITIONS FOR PRIORITY DELIVERY OF GROUND WATER  
IN DISTRICT 13T

An informal conference was held on May 16, 1996, at Grace to commence consideration of the petitions filed by Warren P. Lloyd, Paul N. Christensen, and David Lloyd seeking delivery of ground water rights by priority within Water District 13T. At the conference, the petitioners and the holders of junior priority rights potentially affected by the call discussed various methods of resolving the call without proceeding to a formal hearing. At the conclusion of the conference, the attendees asked the Department of Water Resources to withhold further action on the petitions for a period of time to allow an agreement to be reached to resolve the matter for at least this year.

Based upon this request, the department will withhold further action on the petitions until June 15, 1996. If written notification has not been provided to the department that an agreement has been reached setting aside the petitions for this year, the petitioners shall then serve notice of the petitions on the holder of each water right against which a call is made in accordance with Rule of Procedure IDAPA 37.01.01.203. Proof of service shall be provided to the department in accordance with Rule of Procedure IDAPA 37.01.01.303. The matter will then be heard by the department in accordance with the "Rules for Conjunctive Management of Surface and Ground Water Resources" and the "Rules of Procedure."
