Dear Sirs,

I am writing to clarify what happened with the Pivot belonging to Chad Neibaur located on Hegstrom Road and the 40 acres of non-irrigated land that was unintentionally watered causing this fine. The pivot system was being maintained by both myself as well as Chad Neibaur. We were watering the grain at four tenths of an inch, because of its young stage. The pivot had not yet had the pivot stops installed because we were waiting on Golden West Irrigation to deliver them to us. The Pivot had been checked periodically during the watering but in the early morning hours on Sunday the pivot moved on the non-irrigated ground between the times we had checked causing it to irrigate the non-irrigated acres. This was unintentional and never planned. We had rented this ground from Chad as non-irrigated, had planted and had fertilized it as dry farm ground. This was an unintentional mistake and when we caught the pivot we stopped it, reversed it and ran it back dry off the non-irrigated ground. This was a one time accident that we had tried very hard to avoid happening and when it did we corrected it immediately.


