RE: NOTICE OF WATER DISTRICT MEETING - BANCROFT-LUND AREA

Dear Wateruser:

On May 26, 1995, the Department of Water Resources (department) created a water district for the Bancroft-Lund Area pursuant to the authority in Section 42-604, Idaho Code. The department has subsequently been asked to schedule a water district meeting so a watermaster can be elected and other activities of the district established.

Section 42-605(11), Idaho Code, authorizes the Director of the department to call a special meeting of the water users to provide for the organization and operation of the newly formed water district.

Hence, the department has scheduled a special Water District meeting as follows:

7:00 p.m.

Place:

Grace American Legion Building, 100 North 100 West,

Grace, Idaho.

The purpose of the meeting is to conduct the usual annual business of a water district and includes activities such as the following:

- 1. Establish the compensation of the watermaster before the election of the watermaster and adopt a budget.
- 2. Determine the method of desired voting by majority or by shares.
- 3. Elect a watermaster.
- 4. Elect a secretary.

- 5. Choose an advisory committee.
- 6. Adopt resolutions as appropriate.

All water users holding a valid water right who wish to vote and otherwise participate in the water district meeting must be present at this meeting. Proxy votes are not allowed in a water district election in the absence of the owner of a water right, except that a right may be voted by another person present who has the use of the right for the irrigation season, such as a tenant, lessor or contract purchaser.
