

The following information was not decided at the annual meeting, as it had to be resolved between the County Commissioners and the new Secretary/Treasurer and water master.

It was decided that when the collections came into the tax office that the money would given to District 27 Secretary/Treasurer by a check, which she in turn would deposit it in the bank, where District # 27 has their funds. Funds remaining in the trust account of the County, were given to the Secretary in a check. She then deposited this check into an account with Zions Bank for Blackfoot River Irrigation District 27.
