WATER DISTRICT No. 57-D

Meeting Called to order by Chairman Craig Baker at ¹⁻¹³⁻⁹⁷ 1:25 PM
at the Courthouse in Murphy. In attendance were Paul Nettleton,
Mike Elhi, Craig Baker, John Edwards, Jay Hulet and Cindy
Hodges from IDWR.

Minutes of 1996 meeting were read and approved.

Officers were elected: Craig Baker, Chairman and Paul Nettleton, Sec.

Salary was approved for Watermaster Compensation at \$50 per trip
and 30¢ per mile from home of watermaster (same as last year)

Budget was approved to be the same as last year.

Resolutions were passed:

1. that all water users pay water district fees by
April 1 of current water season.
2. that no water will be delivered to any water user
that is not current in paying water fees.

Discussion:

Cindy reported on the progress of SRBA, announced
that the new Western Region Manager will be Gary Spackman,
replacing Dave Tutthill, and gave a presentation on stream
channel alteration permits and requirements as to emergencies
and flood repair, etc.

There was discussion regarding reservoir and flooding
potential in light of snowpacks that are still at nearly twice
normal.

Meeting adjourned at 2:35 PM.
