When it rains, it pours, I guess.

Partial decrees have been awarded in Basin 57 for at least some of the = Nettleton Sinker Creek irrigation rights and possibly the Hulet storage = right which, in essence, may extend the irrigation season to Nov 15 and = shorten the storage season by the same period. Paul Nettleton just called = inquiring as to how we will administer the new decrees "when Jay goes to = shut down his reservoir on November 1" as he is accustomed to doing. Paul = indicates he is still irrigating and will call for natural flows thru 11/15 = under the new decrees.

I do not yet have an answer for this; Dave and I will likely go to Norm for=

consult before we make a decision. Primary among our concerns are 1) have =

the partial decrees in fact been issued and for what rights, 2) how will the=

Watermaster be formally notified and 3) are we even obligated to deliver any=

partial decrees this season when not all may be awarded yet.

I would suspect you will receive at least one call over this as the situation ripens. Would you please notify all Western staff, especially = your office day folks for today and tomorrow, to refer all end-of-season = calls of this nature to me or to Dave for the time being. We'll let you = know when we have something firm to advise the Watermaster.

As far as Jay's letter goes, John Marshall has determined he really cannot =

contact Jay directly because Jay has retained his own counsel in that matter=

[Dan Steenson), and that Jay's circumventing his counsel to contact the =
department was neither ethical or appropriate, therefore, John is going to =

forward the entire thing to Dan and let Dan deal with Jay.... I like it.
