ADOPTED AT THE ANNUAL MEETING OF THE USERS OF

WATER DISTRICT No. # 63 B

All Resolutions same as Previous years -

Resolved:

That no ditch, canal company or other waterusers shall have the right to demand or receive water and the Watermaster shall not deliver water to such persons until dues fixed by the budget, the amount due and delinquent have been paid.

Resolved:

That when freezing weather comes in fall the ~~water to water~~ water shall be turned out of the ditch by some reliable persons in order to protect canal and headgate.
