Minutes for Meeting of Waterusers #63B

The waterusers of Smith Creek 63B met at the home of Randy Davison, Watermaster, March 7th 2005.

Those attending the meeting were Barbara and Elmer Ireland, Luther Cook, Dean Davison and Randy and Sandy Davison.

Secretary read the minutes of 2004 meeting, gave the bank statement balance of 246.⁰⁸. She also reported that the Home Federal Bank is taking \$5.⁰⁰ a month out of the account for dormancy charges. This has happened for the past five months for a total of \$25.⁰⁰. She will get with the bank and see if the charges can be stopped or if we need to change banks.

Elmer Ireland made a motion to approve the minutes and Dean Davison seconded it.

Dean Davison made a motion for the officers to remain the same and Luther Cook seconded it. The officers are as follows.

Watermaster is to check with secretary when called out. Water District will pay secretary 25.⁰⁰ a year for her expenses if the Watermaster is called out.

Old business was Luther Cook said he did get some new planks for the diversion dam.

New business is that Luther Cook reported there are still some large trees in the canal. Elmer suggested cutting the trees off with a power saw and then winching them out. Luther said he will try to work on the trees in the next few weeks.

All the members discussed the lack of snow this winter and the impact it will have on us this year.
