Discussion: Paul Tuttle reported concerning Murphy Mutual Canal lateral users association. Meeting will follow.

Done reported statewide snow basin damage at 50% of normal. Paul reported 1 1/2 feet of snow in Silver City, estimating that this is also approx. 50% of normal. Recent heavy snow in the watershed may have increased this somewhat. Jay reported his reservoir at approx 17 feet. Craig reported that the lake at basically full with 1 foot of top freboard. Cindy reported on a watermaster violation on the Hest Governor's Report. No action will be taken as no damage was done and it was mostly a misunderstanding. Cindy wanted water users to be aware of the incident and passed out a letter concerning it. There was also brief discussion concerning a benefit we investing flood irrigation from the canal on Joyce Livestock Co. land.
