

2003 meeting called to order 1-2-03 at 1:05 PM at the Owyhee County Courthouse, Rm. #2. Present: Cham. Craig Baker (Sierra Del Rio Park), Sec. Treas. Paul Nettleton (Joyce Ewertach Co.), Doug Hipwell (Edwards Park), Mike Ahli (Kilet Farms), Nick Ahli, watermaster and Dan Nelson, IDWR.

Minutes and Treas. report were read and approved.

Officers were reelected.

Watermaster was reelected as Nick agreed to serve one more year.

Budget was approved same as last year.

Nick requested that some work be done on the headgater and weir at the head of canal below Dam. Mike and Paul agreed to take action on this.

Dan Nelson reported from IDWR about changes in transfer procedures on water applications. Also reported on losing the stream channel alteration program due to budget constraints. All alterations now come under Army Corps of Engineers. Not a good change for water users. Dan advised anyone contemplating stream bed work to contact ERV BALLOU, State office IDWR, 1301 No. Orchard, Boise 83705, ph. 327-5448.

Paul reported a rather poor snowpack in mtns. Recent storms have brought it up to 80 or 90% of average but with soil so dry, at least 120 to 130% will be required for average year. Much moisture is still needed to be adequate.
