Meeting called to order at 7:10 P.M.

Department of Water Resources  
Eastern District

Members present: Jack Hatley, Sheldon Hatley, Bruce Wheatley, Emery Nestor, David Nestor, Reed Capell, Ralph Wheatley and Alan Christensen.

Minutes of March 12, 1993 meeting were read and reviewed. Motion was made by Leland Armstrong to approve minutes. Motion was 2nd by Bruce Wheatley and approved by those present.

Ralph Wheatley reported that the Old Ditch Co. had held a meeting recently. A question was raised concerning assessments. It was answered that assessments were relative to the number of shares of water a member had or fraction thereof, e.g. 1/2 share 1/2 assessment.

It was reported that we have a fund balance of \$1857 at present.

Reviewed needs to change the lateral by Cecil Armstrong's and change the diversion above John Evan's.

Discussed assessments and usage fees. The assessment has been \$50/share with a daily usage fee of \$5/ stream of water. The water master has received \$10/day for each day that water was on turns.

Motions made by Bruce Wheatley to leave assessments and usage fees the same as in the past. Motions and by Sheldon Hatley and approved by those in attendance.

Discussion followed on need to assess members for cleaning and maintaining the canal. Emery Nestor explained problem with cleaning the canals. He said that he has not received help in the past with cleaning the north canal. Bruce Wheatley explained the need to work through the companies in cleaning the canal and obtaining equipment. Jack Hatley asked about the number of diversions on the middle canal. Suggestion considered to divide assessment between maintenance and diversion.

Emery Nestor made motion assess \$25/ share for maintenance and cleaning of canals subject to approval of water resource board. Leland Armstrong 2nd motion which was then approved

Water distribution was then discussed. Bruce Wheatley made motion that each user would get at least one turn after which distribution would revert to the date of the water rights. The Water Master will determine the length of the turns based on the availability of water. Motion was 2nd by Leland Armstrong. and approved by those present.

Users were reminded that assessments must be current before they receive any water.


Leland Armstrong made motion that present officers be retained .. Motion 2nd by Bruce Wheatley and approved.
