Sorry about being late with this information. You will find enclosed a copy of my Rotating Schedule which was used for 2 streams most of the time. Occasionally 3 streams are used.

Harold you will note that number 2 stream shows more water than number 1 stream simply because number 1 stream can only hold a use so much and the remainder which is measured goes down to the second stream or sometimes is not used by either stream. All ~~most~~ measurements are taken at the first diversion point.

You will note measurements were kept in minus inches showing total minus inches and streams showing Weir reading for minus inches.

Harold this system of issuing water seems to work as long as we can all, that is water holders can get along. Other wise they would need to go to priority dates.

From our phone conversation you mention this system did not fit the standard forms of reporting on shares, so if there is a way or different form we can use for reporting please let us know.

Hope this is what you wanted, copies of all our records including this form I recall were sent to Water Resources in Boise.
