Dear Mr. Coleman;

We are still holding your claim of 4-21-97 for water-district expenses due to an apparent discrepancy with the last year's watermaster report. The report shows that \$500 is due for the secretary's salary, and another \$500 is due for miscellaneous expenses. The bill only shows \$224.60 for miscellaneous expenses, however, plus the \$500 for the secretary. I have holding the claim until this discrepancy can be resolved, but nothing has happened so far.


