Water Master Job Description:

1. Check all headgates and weirs before April 1st. Make sure all headgates, ditches, and weirs are cleaned and repaired before water is turned on.
2. Make sure all water payments are made.
3. Make sure water is turned at a reasonable time or call, unless other arrangements have been made.
4. Check with the state and fill out paper work.
5. Make sure feeders are correctly measuring the water.
6. Beneficial to attend watermaster school in Twin Falls.
7. Pay own expenses and taxes.
8. Water master is to attend water meeting and report on work needs to be done and problems.
9. Make sure all water users receive water schedule card.
10. 10% of wages will be withheld until all paper work has been filed with the state.
