# Watermaster's Annual Report

I commend the Water District User's as a whole for the overall cooperation on the short fall of water during this last irrigation season. We did work as a team when it counted, everybody did their part and I Thank You.

I have indicated to the Water District Advisory Council and Mr. John Burrows that I was not going on a witch hunt, due to the problems that were encountered, with the Pomerelle Ski and U.S. Forest Service. I did indicate that I had already encountered a snowball effect on users where they were not in line legally, and they would be worked on as I could find the time, but it would be rectified.

## **AREAS OF CONCERN**

### Marsh Creek Drainage:

Tom Geary, The West slope drainage needs diversion head gates and measuring device(s).

A.W. Anderson needs a head gate and measuring device for water diversion off of West slope channel NW of Geary's.

The Albion City needs to reconsider their delivery channel off of Don Merrill, this would eliminate the problem that still occurs on rotation or call for water, its not being passed on.

# Starrh Ditch Delivery System:

Between the Users and the Albion Hwy District, the delivery ditch needs to be repaired to enable the delivery of water this coming season. Also, there needs to be a measuring device at the forks of the starrh and to the Adams's, and Bailey channel, with the parties working their own delivery system.

Ben Chatburn needs to repair his diversion off of Marsh Creek so he is not pumping from main creek for his sprinklers.

## Land Creek:

6S Ranch needs to get a screw down head gate and measuring device placed at diversion 'B' (middle diversion point), a Parshall Flume would work.

#### White Pine Creek:

Needs a head gate and measuring device at the Primary Diversion Points of the main channel. As it stands, all points of diversion of this creek are illegal at this point of time.

#### Brim Creek:

The main channel does not have any legal diversion and measuring devices on the creek. I found this last season, two points of diversion going towards the Clarks, also the designated water right to Ina Droz's has been washed out over many years, the water delivered is to one place and that's for live stock use, over the years. Since the Berritt ditch is part of the original Brim Creek at George Kelleys, both culverts, North of the house and where Mark Griggs placed a road through the creek and not placing a culvert at that point creates a delivery problem when water has been called by Willis for irrigation. This needs to be rectified by Grigg's.

Also, on the Berritt ditch, there needs to be head gates of some sort to eliminate the cutting and erosion of banks. Example is at Gunderson's and the diverting of water to the North meadow of Alan Clarks. One other, is to put a culvert where White Pine crosses the Berritt delivery ditch.

#### Rose Creek:

Main channel Weir and diversion head gate with a measuring device, placed at the upper meadow approximately 100-150 feet off the fence line. Joe Peterson has been shown where the Watermaster believes it should be placed.

## Broad Hollow Creek:

I recommend that a head gate and measuring device be placed on the main channel where the water has been diverted West of Mahoney's. Reason is, this last year I had no water to measure at the regular areas that Broad Hollow crosses Brim ditch. I have a feeling that it has been washed out or has been diverted back to Howell Creek. I say this because from up on top of the ridge I could see water in the channel, I did not hike to the diversion point.

## Antone / Pine Creek: (Clyde)!!

The main channel at 1<sup>st</sup> diversion point Grant Clark (Antone), a diversion screw down head gate, placed with a measuring device installed. A 2<sup>nd</sup> diversion placed where Fred Hawker diverts his water, with a measuring device head gate. The Pine Creek channel was designated by Grant Clark last June 16, 2000 to both the Water District Advisory Council and the Watermaster 45F. Mr. Clark was informed that the water would stay in main channel until legal head gate and measuring device was implemented.

Mr. Grant Clark also, did a lot of development on his upper meadows and Greg Jones, Adjudication's Officer with the Department of Water Resources and myself had a review on his project indicating that he was tapping into a spring and that under the circumstances Grant could not be stopped in laying the pipe but that he could not connect the system up and that he needed to get his water rights in line. As of March 1, 2001 this has not happened.

## Asher Creek/Cow Gulch & Billing:

Need to get with Leo Bell and Randy Brackenbury in resolving 1999/2000 billing which Leo fills is incorrect. I got with Ron Sorensen at the time he requested assistance, I laid the problem out at that time (March 18<sup>th</sup>, 2000).

Also, I need to get with Leo Bell and his diversion of Asher Creek and the intermingling of water with Cow Gulch. Leo does have a legal right to Cow Gulch but there is no water right allocated on Asher Creek. I have taken pictures of the problem and did notify the Water District of the problem, to be resolved at a later date. This was written up April 14, 2000. There is also, other problems that need to be addressed.
