RESOLUTIONS PERTAINING TO THE TIME AND MANNER OF COLLECTING THE BUDGET AS
ADOPTED AT THE ANNUAL MEETING OF THE USERS OF

Meeting Minutes Of Upper Ratt River Water District 43-B

A meeting for Ratt River Water District 43-B water users was held January 15, 1996 at the Ratt River Electric building in Malta, Idaho. The meeting began at 2:10 PM. Those in attendance were Jay Harper, Robert Hope, Alan Harper, Brian Hansen, Reid Stewart, H. Olen Ward and Lano Elison.

Items of business included the following:

1. Minutes of last years annual meeting were read by Jay Harper. The minutes were approved.
2. Jay Harper was elected to serve as chairman for the meeting.
3. Robert Hope was elected secretary of the district by unanimous vote.
4. A discussion was held concerning the ponding of water by a dam and standpipe in the river channel below Reed Springs. Letters of correspondence between owners of the pond and personnel from Idaho Department of Water Resources (IDWR) were discussed. IDWR cannot find records that authorize water usage or storage by the owners of the pond. An application form for a permit to store water in a pond was sent to the owners of the pond.
5. It was moved and seconded that a credentials committee not be appointed to decide the number of votes each water user is entitled to cast.
6. It was moved and seconded that the watermasters salary remain the same as last year at \$65.00 per day and \$30.00 per half day. Motion carried. It was moved that the watermaster should charge for half a day up to 4 hours and a full day for over 4 hours. Motion was approved.
7. Robert Hope was elected to continue as watermaster by unanimous vote and that he should continue to serve on a year round basis until his successor is duly elected and qualified.
8. The watermaster's proposed budget for 1996 was presented and approved by unanimous vote.
9. It was approved that Water District 43-B adopt code 42-617 to assure collection of assessments. Code 42-617 reads:

"No ditch, canal company, or water user shall have the right to demand and receive water, and the watermaster shall not deliver to such person until the amount due and payable from user as fixed by the budget, has been paid."

10. Douglas Freestone was elected to continue as treasurer for the District. The secretary will continue to keep the financial records for the District.
11. The Advisory Committee was elected to remain the same as last year. Jay Harper, Douglas Freestone, and Roscoe Ward will serve as the Advisory Committee to resolve problems that may arise.
12. Workmans Compensation Insurance was discussed. State law defines the Water District as a public employer which requires the purchase of Workmans Compensation Insurance for employees.
13. Individual billing assessments for members in the Malta Land and Irrigation unit was discussed. Individual names will be submitted to the Cassia County Assessor for personal billing statements in the future.
14. The meeting adjourned at 4:05 PM.
