7. READING OF MINUTES AND TREASURE'S REPORT:
MINUTES AND TREASURER'S REPORT WERE READ AND APPROVED.
8. FIX WATERMASTER'S COMPENSATION:
A MOTION TO PAY THE WATERMASTER \$50.00 PER DAY WAS ADOPTED.
9. ELECTION OF WATERMASTER:
NOMINATIONS WERE TOMMY HUTCHISON, NEAL TWICHELL AND
LEONARD HALL.

TOMMY HUTCHISON WAS ELECTED TO BE WATERMASTER FOR 1994 BY
SECRET BALLOT

A FEW MINUTES WAS GIVEN TO KELLY CHRISTENSEN OF THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES TO TALK TO US ABOUT THE PENDING COURT RULING CONCERNING THE FILLING OF OLDER WATER RIGHTS.

10. OLD BUSINESS:

HARRY DSCHAAK ASKED ABOUT THE RESEVOIR WHICH HAD BEEN DISCUSSED MANY YEARS AGO AND WAS TOLD BY MANY MEMBERS THAT IT WAS A DEAD ISSUE. MR. CHRISTENSEN AGREED THAT THERE WAS LITTLE CHANCE OF THAT BEING RENEWED.

GLEN PARKE ASKED WHEN THE WATERMASTER CAN BE CALLED TO WORK AND IT WAS AGREED THAT THE RULING IS ANYTIME AFTER APRIL 1ST.

ART WARD ASKED IF WE WERE PLANNING ANY WORK ON THE MAIN DITCHES BECAUSE OF BEAVER DAMAGE. TOM HUTCHISON SAID THAT SOME WORK HAD BEEN ATTEMPTED BUT WERE TOLD BY THE WATER RESOURCES BOARD THAT THE ONLY WORK ALLOWED WAS WITH SHOVEL AND CHAINSAW.

11. NEW BUSINESS:

LINDY NEDDO COMMENTED THAT HE UNDERSTOOD THAT THE MEETING WAS ALWAYS SUPPOSED TO BE HELD THE FIRST MONDAY IN MARCH. HE ALSO ASKED IF MEMBERS WERE AWARE THAT THE BOUNDARY LINE BETWEEN THE UPPER AND LOWER FLOOD CONTROL BOUNDARIES. HE INDICATED THAT IT HAD BEEN MOVE UP 5 MILES. MEMBERS WENT ON RECORD AS BEING OPPOSED TO THE MOVING OF THAT BOUNDARY

LINE AND FELT THAT IT SHOULD BE MOVED BACK TO ITS ORIGINAL POSITION.. THE QUESTION WAS ALSO RAISED ABOUT THE BAR M WATER AND KELLY CHRISTENSEN IS GOING TO CHECK INTO BOTH OF THOSE THINGS.

CHARLIE WARD MADE A MOTION TO BUDGET \$500.00 FOR MAINTENANCE ON THE MAIN CHANNEL AND FOR HEADGATE WORK. THIS MOTION WAS UNANIMOUSLY PASSED BY THE MEMBERS.

12. ADOPTION OF THE BUDGET:

A. WATERMASTER COMPENSATION (215 DAYS AT \$50.00 PER DAY)	\$10,750.00

13. ADOPTION OF RESOLUTION AND COLLECTION OF BUDGET:

THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS VOTED AND UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED:

"THAT NO DITCH OR CANAL COMPANY OR OTHER WATER USER SHALL HAVE THE RIGHT TO DEMAND AND RECEIVE WATER AND THE WATERMASTER SHALL NOT DELIVER TO SUCH PERSON UNTIL THE AMOUNT DUE AND PAYABLE FROM SUCH AS FIXED BY THE BUDGET HAS BEEN PAID. SAID AMOUNTS SHALL BECOME DUE AND PAYABLE FIFTEEN DAYS AFTER RECEIPT OF WATER BILLS AND SAID AMOUNTS, IF NOT PAID, SHALL BEAR INTEREST AT THE RATE OF 8 % PER ANNUM. ALSO, THE WATER USER MUST PRESENT TO THE WATERMASTER HIS PAID RECEIPT OR OTHER PROOF THAT HIS BUDGET HAS BEEN PAID BEFORE HE CAN DEMAND HIS WATER."

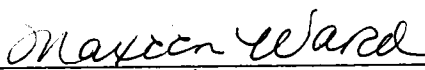
14. ADVISORY COMMITTEE :
