Meeting Minutes of Upper Raft River Water District 43-B


A meeting of Raft River Water District 43-B water users was held January 10, 1994 at the Raft River Rural Electric building in Malta, Idaho. The meeting began at 2:10 P.M. Those in attendance were Robert Hope, Doug Freestone, Olen Ward, Richard Miller, Alan Harper, Bruce Durfee, and James E. Stanton from the Idaho Department of Water Resources.

Alan Harper was elected to serve as chairman for the meeting. Alan read the minutes from last years meeting.

Items of business included the following:

1. Robert Hope was elected secretary of the District by unanimous vote.
2. Doug Freestone was elected to continue as treasurer for the District.
3. Robert Hope was elected to continue as watermaster by unanimous vote and that he should serve continuously until his successor is duly elected and qualified.
4. Jay Harper, Doug Freestone, and Boyd Booth were unanimously approved to continue as the advisory committee for the District.
5. It was moved and seconded that a credentials committee not be appointed to ascertain the number of votes each water user is entitled to cast.
6. The watermasters proposed budget of \$1680.00 was approved for the 1994 season. The watermasters pay will remain the same at \$55.00 per day or \$27,50 per half day.
7. Idaho Code 42-617 was adopted to assure collection of water District 43-B assessments. Code 42-617 reads:
"No ditch, canal company, or water user shall have the right to demand and receive water and the watermaster shall not deliver to such person until the amount due and payable from user as fixed by the budget, has been paid".
8. The Secretary will continue to keep the financial records for the District.
9. It was unanimously approved that those who use water during the year pay their pro-rated share of the water Districts expenses. Those who do not use water will not be required to pay.
10. It was approved that water users provide a measuring device so the watermaster can determine amounts of water being used.
11. The Secretary will write a letter to the Dept. of Water Resources concerning ponding of water near Reed Springs.

The next meeting for water users in District 43-B will be January 9, 1995.

Meeting Minutes of Upper Raft River Water District 43-B

A meeting for Raft River Water District 43-B water users was held January 11, 1993 at the Raft River Rural Electric building in Malta, Idaho. The meeting began at 2:15 PM. Those in attendance were Robert Hope, Doug Freestone, Boyd Booth, Jack Erickson, Bruce Durfee and Alan Harper.

It was moved and seconded that Jay Harper continue as chairman of the Water District Advisory Committee. It was moved and seconded that Boyd Booth serve as acting chairman for this meeting. Boyd Booth read the minutes from last years meeting.

Items of business included the following:

1. Robert Hope was elected secretary of the District by unanimous vote.
2. Robert Hope was elected to continue as Watermaster by unanimous vote and that he should serve continuously until his successor is duly elected and qualified.
3. Doug Freestone was elected Treasurer by unanimous vote.
4. Jay Harper, Doug Freestone and Boyd Booth were retained to serve as the advisory committee for the District.
5. It was moved and seconded that the Credentials Committee not be appointed as those water users in attendance reviewed and approved the Watermasters Report and proposed budget for 1993. The budget is to remain the same as last years budget of \$1680.00.
6. It was unanimously approved that the Watermaster's salary of \$55.00 per day should remain the same as last year.
7. It was resolved that Idaho Code 42-617 be adopted to assure collection of Water District 43-B assessments.

Code 42-617 reads:

"No ditch, canal company, or water user shall have the right to demand and receive water, and the watermaster shall not deliver to such person until the amount due and payable from user, as fixed by the budget, has been paid".

8. The Secretary will continue to keep the financial records for the district.
9. It was moved and seconded that those who use water during the year pay their pro-rated share of the Water District expenses. Those who do not use water will not be required to pay.
10. It was unanimously approved that water users be required to provide a measuring device so that the watermaster can determine amounts of water being used.

In reference to last years meeting minutes, it was concluded that pumpers who affect Reed Springs should be requested to pay a pro-rated cost for the watermaster to measure Reed Springs. Requests for payments were sent out and the pumpers did pay the requested amounts.

The next meeting for water users in District 43-B will be January 10, 1994
