In addition to the submission of these names Norm the Directors would like to add what they think might be a starting point for the committee that you choose.

- l) Consideration of a maximum depth level of domestic wells (ie-l20 ft) at which time all irrigation wells within a certain radius would be turned off, enlarging that radius until such time as the domestic well water is returned.
- 2) Installation of a Domestic Community well in the area affected.
- 3) A series of wells that would pump directly into the river to recharge the river bed.
- 4) Hold all of the river to Decrees, thereby allowing excess waters to flow down the river bed.
- 5) Expand the BLRID to include all irrigators for better management.
- 6) Place a moratorium on all land and development expansion.

Tuesday of February of each year, beginning with the year 1937, levy and fix such toll charges, which toll charges will be the total amount required for such expenses.

Sec.2.The Board of Directors ,in its order fixing or levying such tolls each year shall fix the date of May 1st as the date on which the levy must be paid and shall require the same payable in advance of the delivery of any water during the year for which the same are fixed, and may make provision for the collection thereof and the keeping of a toll book by the District Treasurer.

Sec.3.no owner or user of decreed water will be permitted to store water in the District reservoir until such time as all assessments of every kind and character due said district against said decreed water and against the land to which said decreed water and against the land to which said decreed water is appurtenant, have been paid.

Sec.4. The District has the right to refuse delivery of any water until all current as well as past due assessments have been paid.

ARTICLE XI

SEAL

Sec.I.The corporate seal of this district shall have engrave thereon the full name of the District and the name of the State.

Sec.2. The corporate seal of this District shall always remain in the custody of the Secretary at the office located in Mackay.

ARTICLE X11

Section 1: These By-Laws may be altered, amended, or repealed at any regular meeting of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE X111 POSSESION OF BY LAWS

Section 1: These By-Laws shall always remain in the possession of the Secretary of District and kept in the office of the District at Mackay.
