Dear Keith

The Lost River Water users met the night following our meeting in Arco and has put together a list of people which we feel have the qualifications to serve on the committee. These people are not necessarily ones that we have contacted and talked to about the situation but just citizens with interest in areas that we think qualifies them to serve.

The member that we recommend from the Irrigation District would be the newest elected member who has the longest to serve of his term, and is also the secretary of the board Richard Reynolds of Moore, Idaho.

To represent water district #34 we think it would be better to have a member of the board rather than a salaried employee. we therefore suggest Alvin Crawford the chairman.

To represent the pumpers above Moore either Randy Damiana of Moore who is a primary pumper or Duane Haney of Moore who pumps except for a little storage water.

Below Moore a person who fills the bill for both a supplemental pumper and a late decree holder we recommend Dale Smith of Moore.

Our choice for an early decree holder is Larman Andersen of Moore.

The late decree holder who also is a supplemental pumper that we think would do well is Lawrence Babcock of Moore.

To represent domestic well users Lewis Rothwell will serve well.

We have several choices for persons to fill the position representing economic interests Sherry Maynard a retail business person who belongs to the Chamber of Commerce and has broad community interest. Sherry's address is Moore. Additionally either Bob Sherman of Arco another retail businessman with wildlife interest or Curtis Reay of Arco

The member of the Idaho wildlife council and a member of the Chamber of Commerce is Steve Atwood of Arco.


Our choice for the representation of Municipalities would be either Lyn Pearson the Moore Mayor or Glen Guthrie who is also a local well driller.

From above the dam Herb Whitworth would probably do a good job.

We would not presume to recommend anyone to represent the development interests but think that you should keep in mind that there are only about six to eight families in that category.

If we can be of any further help please let us know and we will do whatever we can.
