Re: 1994 Ground Water Measurements and Estimate of Withdrawals

Dear Ms. Jensen:

Thank you for promptly responding to my correspondence of May 2, 1995. As you correctly noted, it appears that we did overlook a water right which is diverted from your well in Township 5N, Range 26E, Section 27, SWSWSW.

I have reviewed the water right transfer of right no. 34-02357B. This transfer was approved in October of 1993. The transfer changed the point of diversion for 2.00 cfs under right 34-02357 from a well located in Township 4N, Range 26E, section 23, SWSE to your well in Township 5N, Range 26E, section 27. The rate of diversion under the transferred right should have been added to the existing rights from your well.

Based on the approved transfer, the total combined rate of diversion from your well in section 27 is 6.80 cfs, not 4.80 cfs as indicated by my last letter. The water district's 1994 measurement of 5.95 cfs is considerably less than the maximum allowed 6.80 cfs. IDWR therefore has no concern at this time regarding any excessive diversion from this well during 1994. Additional monitoring efforts will not be required for this well. Water district staff will make an effort to conduct its' usual annual spot check and discharge measurement of the well.

Again, thank you for your prompt response and clarifying information. I apologize for having overlooked the transfer and any inconvenience this may have caused.
