

Following the motion and December 19, 1995 hearing on continued interim administration in Reporting Area 1 (Basin 34),

## IT IS ORDERED as follows:

- 1. Interim Administration in Reporting Area 1 (Basin 34) shall continue on the basis that the respective rights and priorities of claimants in this area shall be administered as they were reported in the director's report. In the past, these rights and priorities have been referred to as the "list" to be used by the Idaho Department of Water Resources for purposes of interim administration. Administration in Basin 34 shall continue on this same basis subject to the modifications in paragraph 2 below.
- 2. The list for interim administration described in paragraph 1 shall be modified or supplemented by the following:
  - a. Standard Form 5 settlement documents which have been executed by all parties in contested cases and by the Idaho Department of Water Resources and which have been accepted for filing by the Special Master.
  - b. Partial or Final Decrees entered by the Presiding Judge.

This Order shall continue in force and effect permanently until modified or dissolved by the Court.

IT IS SO ORDERED.

The Motion for Extension of Interim Administration is **GRANTED**.

On November 30, 1994, Mitchell Sorenson, a claimant in Basin 34, filed a Motion for Partial Lifting of Stay to Consider: Motion for Extension of Order of Interim Administration in Reporting Area 1 (Basin 34) (Motion for Extension). Hearing was held on this motion at the SRBA's monthly status conference on February 21, 1995.

The original order allowing interim administration in Basin 34, Order Modifying Order Granting Idaho Department of Water Resources' Motion for Interim Administration with Limitations (Original Order), was entered on May 24, 1993 and expired by its own terms on December 31, 1993. By order dated February 28, 1994 (Order Granting Interim Administration in Reporting Area 1 (Basin 34)), this court extended interim administration of this area until the expiration of the 1994 irrigation season. The Motion for Extension requests another extension for the 1995 irrigation season.
