The district met this day with the following present: Richard Free, Wes Beutler, Jeff Johnson, Clair Bosen, Earl Ward, Ivan Jensen, Bob Erickson, and Michael Kunz.

The minutes of March 1, 2004 were read and approved on motion from Jeff Johnson and seconded by Clair Bosen.

Jeff Johnson moved that the water assessments be collected prior to the irrigation season, which was seconded by Bob Erickson and passed.

The tour taken last year was interesting and helped to understand where the water comes from. It was noted that water adjudication on Bear River will be handled in a few years and people will need to prove up on their water.

A budget of \$2800 (\$2500 wage and \$300 for workers compensation) was proposed. It was moved by Clair Bosen to accept it and seconded by Wes Beutler which passed unanimously.

Clair Bosen moved that we leave the officers and watermaster the same as last year, which was seconded by Jeff Johnson and passed. Richard Free will be president, Michael Kunz will be secretary, and Bob Erickson will be watermaster.

Wes Beutler moved that the meeting adjourn which was seconded by Jeff Johnson and passed.

The meeting adjourned at 11:20am.
