Minutes of Rockland Water District No. 41

The annual water meeting held at the Rockland School Annex Mar. 6, 1995 was called to order by chairman Merrill Walker at 1 o'clock p.m. Walker welcomed those present including Mr. Kelly Christiansen from the *Dept of water* resources from Twin Falls. Chairman Walker asked for minutes and report from Sec. Harold Permann. He stated he had had a lot of problems with the I.R. S. and Social Security and with Carol Schrieber. Not reporting all the facts, made 7 trips to Am. Falls but finally got Virginia Frisk who deals with all Social Security for Lampherst and Co. in Pocatello. Within a month she had everything settled and peace with Social Security in Ogden. Chairman Walker asked for a motion to elect a Chairman and Sec. and Treasurer for next year 1995. Ron Nelson made a motion we retain the same chairman and Sec. and Treasurer. Seconded by Jim Woodworth. Motion carried. Chairman asked for amount to pay Water Master, Sec. and Treasurer and Social Security. Richard Nelson made a motion we assess water users for Amt. of:

Motion made by Kelvin Tayson to accept this budget. Seconded by Ron Spillett. Motion carried. Chairman asked if there were any applications for water master. Robinson said he would apply. Jim Woodworth said Alan Woodworth would apply. Mr. Robinson was elected water master for 1995 season. Motion made by Kelvin Tayson, *to accept Robinson for 1995 season* seconded by Ron Spillett. Motion carried. Chairman Walker asked for a report by water master. He reported there were times when he was short of water in different places he would draw water from Leonard May and Rodger Sant to take care of the shortage.

There was much discussion on water and its uses and what will happen if we use the new method of measuring and if Mr. Christiansen would be giving us a cut on water to send it to Twin Falls or Snake River. Mr. Christiansen stated he wouldn't do anything to give us care or concern. Mr. Walker appointed Kelvin Tayson and Ron Spillett as Credential Committee. Advisory Comm. appointed was Jim Woodworth, Mrs. Roper and Curtis Munk. Mr. *Reynold* Ralphs asked if a pump installed in the creek shouldn't be adjusted the same as creek water when water is short, no conclusion. Mr. Walker stated we would have an audit this year for Sec. and Treasurer. Ron Nelson made motion we adjourn at 3:40 p.m. Twin Falls called Mar. 7, and said there would be no audit this year.
