Annual Water District #41 Meeting

March 7, 2005 Minutes

The annual water meeting was held at the Rockland School March 7, 2005 and was called to order by chairman, Brent Walker at 1pm.

Chairman Walker asked for the minutes of the previous meeting to be read. A motion was made by Charles Barnard to approve the minutes and seconded by James Robinson. Voting was unanimous.

Chairman Walker asked for a motion to elect a Chairman and a Seceretary/Treasurer for the upcoming year. Motion to retain Brent Walker as Chairman and Alan Permann as the Secretary/Treasurer was made by James Robinson and seconded by Gene Nelson. Voting was unanimous.

Watermaster Robinson then gave a report on the previous water year. He said that 2004 was better than the previous year because of the timely spring rains. Water was cut into the west ditch, but not as far as the previous year. Assessments for some ditches will be up in cost and others will be down based on the water that was delivered. James stated that all ditches can take as much water as they want early in the spring, until adjustments need to be made.

James feels that we need a 10% increase in the Watermaster's salary due to a 3% cost of living increase over each of the past 3 years. After some discussion it was agreed to include a 10% increase in the Watermaster's and Secy/Treas.'s salary.

The 2005 Budget was then presented as follows:

Motion was made that the Advisory Committee remain the same for 2005 by Bonnie Anderson, and seconded by Gene Nelson. Motion carried.

The Advisory Committee consists of the following individuals; Jim Woodworth, Curtis Munk, and Lance Roper. The voting was unanimous.

James Robinson made a motion to adjourn the meeting until next year. Charles Barnard seconded this. Voting was unanimous. The meeting was adjourned at 1:50pm.
