ANNUAL WATER DISTRICT #41 MEETING MAY 16 2001 March 5, 2001 Minutes

The annual water meeting was held at the Rockland School March 5, 2001 and was called to order by chairman, Brent Walker at 1 p.m. Chairman Walker asked for the minutes of the previous meeting to be read. These were approved by Lance Roper and seconded by James Robinson.

Chairman Walker asked for a motion to elect a Chairman and a Secretary/Treasurer for the next year. Motion to retain Brent Walker as Chairman was made by Rick Nelson and seconded by Lance Roper. Motion to retain Alan Permann as Secretary/Treasurer was made by Rick Nelson and seconded by Lance Roper. Voting was unanimous.

Watermaster Robinson, reported that for the year 2000 water was a little shorter especially South Fork and Landing. Some structures were in need of repair. East Fork and U.S. Ditch were adequate. Lance Roper mentioned they had moss problems in their ditch. James Robinson mentioned that each ditch is responsible for their own screw gate and measuring box. Alice Cox asked why those on Woods ditch had to refile. She said she never remembered getting a notice in the mail to refile and it has cost them \$100.00 each. They have a court hearing on March 20th in American Falls. James Robinson mentioned that we have no way of knowing who received notices because they were mailed some 10 years ago and came from either Twin Falls or Boise.

Motion was made to set Watermaster salary at \$4,500.00 a year by Lance Roper and seconded by Rick Nelson. Voting was unanimous. Application for Watermaster was made by James Robinson. Motion to accept this application was made by Bonnie Anderson and seconded by Lance Roper. Voting was unanimous.
