Minutes of 1998 of Water Master Election meeting and finance report were read by Secretary and  
Treasurer Ronald Peck. Jerry Cenarrusa moved that they be approved as read. Seconded by  
Theron Fiscus. Approved

A proposed budget of \$17,763.00 was presented by Secretary and Treasurer Ronald Peck.
