Re: Water level at Dilworth Dam
Date: February 1st, 2006

Kathy Roberts called the Department on January 30th, 2006 to express her concern of the water level of a dam owned by Mr. Dilworth along Highway I-84 near Hammett, Idaho. In previous years water encroached along the interstate and the Department required that flashboards in the spillway shall not exceed 47". On February 1st, 2006 Rob Whitney and I visited the site to verify the height of the boards in the spillway. The boards remain unchanged at 47 inches. The water level was just below the crest of the boards during the inspection. Some tumbleweeds on the upstream side of the boards are piling up, but did not increase the water level of the reservoir during the visit.
