Dear Mayor Stauts:

IDWR received your letter dated May 29, 2007 regarding the status of permit number 71-7129, with regard to both licensing and the need to install a controlling works and measuring device. I have reviewed the file for permit number 71-7129 and I have spoken with Tim Luke and reviewed his notes from a phone conversation with Mr. Mumford on April 14, 2007. Based on this information, item numbers 1 and 2 in your letter are accurate.

The license will be issued with a rate of diversion and irrigated area below the threshold specified in the February 20, 2007 order requiring controlling works and measuring devices. Consequently, the City of Stanley is exempt from the requirements of that order and no further action is required by the City on this matter. Additionally, the water right license for permit 71-7129 will be issued by IDWR and no further action is required by the City for that to occur.

Dear Sir;

City of Stanley councilman Herb Mumford attended the Water Resources Workshop, Friday, April 6, 2007, at the Mountain Village Conference Room, in Stanley. He also discussed with Tim Luke the specific case of the well at the Stanley City Hall/Community Building, ref. 71-7129, which appears in the list, Attachment A, of your letter of February 20, 2007. Herb also spoke with Tim Luke by telephone on April 9, 2007, about the pending water right for this well and beneficial use. Through those discussions, the following was established:

1. The actual beneficial use of water from this well is below the threshold of 0.24cfs and therefore does not require the installation of a measuring device, and consequently, no further action is required of the City of Stanley in response to the order.
2. The Permit to Appropriate Water No. 71-07129 issued May 3, 1990, and subsequent field examination have established the beneficial use of the water. The water right can now be issued and should reflect a diversion rate less than the 0.24cfs threshold of the order. We understand that the water right should be forthcoming and there is no further action required by the City of Stanley for the water right to be issued.

If there is any misunderstanding above, or if any further action is required by the City of Stanley, please let us know by return mail. Otherwise we understand that no further response is required on our part.
