RESOLUTIONS PERTAINING TO THE TIME AND MANNER OF COLLECTING THE BUDGET AS ADOPTED AT THE ANNUAL MEETING OF THE USERS OF

WATER DISTRICT No. 74-A

Watermaster to be paid 4 times per season:
4/15/96, 6/15/96, 8/15/96 and 11/15/96 *

* The watermaster's final paycheck after the Department of Water Resources receives the 1996 watermaster's Report & the locks have been removed from all headgates.

All assessments are due & payable April 1, 1996
No water user shall have the right to demand and receive water, and the watermaster shall not deliver water to such persons, until their assessment as set by the current Budget, is paid in full.

The watermaster will begin duties on April 1, 1996 and end them November 1, 1996 or when all water users are finished irrigating, whichever comes first.

That when one water user has his water shut off, the watermaster will notify other users who then may want to use it. Irrigation water to be equally divided among all water users.
