Members of Water District 36A met for their annual meeting on Monday, March 4, 2002, at 1 p.m. at Frogs Meeting Room. 42 members and guests were in attendance.

Chairman Dan Yore presided.

The March 5, 2001, minutes were read by the Secretary. Frank Erwin mentioned that we have received word that the State Law does not allow us to charge any more than 10% interest on delinquent assessments. Secretary is to make this notation on 2001 meeting minutes. Minutes approved with information addition.

The Chairman introduced Cindy Yenter from the Idaho Department of Water Resources. She presented a talk and slide presentation on the formation of the New Water Districts and particularly #130. She gave a history of happenings starting about 1 year ago and up to the present time. Dan Yore and Larry Cope have been attending the formation meetings for these districts.
