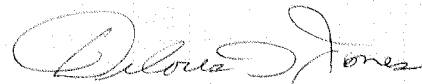

Lynn Babington moved that Deloris Jones be Secretary and Treasurer for the coming year. Dave Bruhn seconded. Carried.

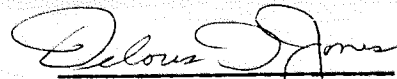

Water Master Frank Erwin reported that he was called out about 4 times last year and mostly for information.

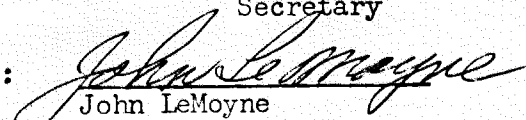
Motion by Bill Jones to elect Frank Erwin as Watermaster for the coming year. Seconded and approved by acclamation.
