
Sections 42-613 and 42-617, Idaho Code Annotated, provide:

RESOLUTIONS PERTAINING TO THE TIME AND MANNER OF COLLECTING THE BUDGET AS  
ADOPTED AT THE ANNUAL MEETING OF THE WATER USERS OF

WATER DISTRICT No. 32-C

RESOLUTIONS

HEADGATES AND WEIRS

All control devices and measuring devices shall be in good working order before water can be demanded and delivered. The watermaster shall not deliver any water unless such devices are in good working order.

COLLECTION OF WATER ASSESSMENTS

That no ditch, canal, or other water user shall have the right to demand and receive water until full payment due is paid. Payment shall become due April 1, 1994, and shall become delinquent May 1, 1994, and if not paid by May 1, 1994, the payment shall bear interest from May 1, 1994, at the rate of eight percent (8%) per annum.

The watermaster shall not deliver any water until full payment due is paid.

WATERMASTER TERM OF SERVICE

That the watermaster shall be elected for a term of one full year. The purpose is so the watermaster can serve in the legal capacity to do official business for the district in the event of emergencies, legislative actions, hearings, disputes or other water related or job related activities. The watermaster cannot be required to make water deliveries before April 1, or after November 1, (the normal irrigation season) unless an emergency exists. The watermaster shall not be paid before April 1, or after November 1, from water district budgeted regular funds.

SPRINKLER IRRIGATION

To prohibit sprinklers pumping directly from Medicine Lodge Creek as per the motion adopted in 1980 which read as follows: That no additional sprinkler pumping be allowed from Medicine Lodge Creek or its tributaries, without first diverting water into a private pond or sump, to eliminate any interference with regulation of stream waters.

RESOLUTION

Be it resolved that the water users of Medicine Lodge Creek unanimously agree and direct the watermaster to continue the practice of water right exchanges, which has been practiced since the formation of the stipulation and agreement dated March 2, 1954. Such practices shall include pooling of waters, rented waters, and exchanges beneficial to the users as a whole. The watermaster is further directed not to deliver the above mentioned waters to a downstream user, until that water delivery amount (c.f.s.) is assessed a bed loss value to provide that no injury to an existing water right would occur. These losses should be assessed as follows: water delivered downstream to a point of the Webster Diversion = 4.0%, Rowland Diversion = 6.0%, Eden Diversion = 10.0% & to the Woodfield Diversion = 10.0% plus the measured percent of bed loss from the Eden Diversion to the Woodfield Diversion as determined by the measurements of the watermaster.

We further resolve that delivery of the above waters cannot be demanded prior to May 1, unless excess water exists in the stream.
