Compensation: \$5.00 per stream or \$10.00 per day until water goes below 200 inches and then \$5.00 per day until end of season.

Check into stock water rights for year round use in the center lateral?**

Assessments: GCIC will vote on the assessments and usage fees for everyone, per the by-laws. They will let Derald know.

**Discussion was opened about the funds in the account.
We have one account now for the water district and GCIC.
Brian made motion to split the funds 50/50 after collection of assessments, usage fees and after this years bills are paid
Seconded by Wendell. Motioned passed**
