

## Water District 29d water master summary report 2011

This report contains a brief summary of the activities, and duties performed by the water master during the term of service. The year started out with a wet and cold spring with late flooding along the Portneuf River, due to a good snow pack that made for plenty of water for the districts water users. Some streams flowed this year that had not had any water available in previous years. Most of my time was spent in inventory inspections on the Portneuf River. I divided the river into three sections, namely upper, middle, and lower sections. There were a lot of inspections to look at, and people to contact. All of the inspections used pump systems to deliver water to place of use. I reviewed with owners the amount of cfs that they were allowed to use. In some instances pumps are over designed and could potentially use more than would be allowed. I also spent time researching current owner records to assist in late assessments collection. Time was also spent inspecting a couple of illegal uses of water and resolving the issue. There are a few remaining diversion inspection, most are scattered, with some smaller streams to look at if required..There were two temporary water permits given for road construction for the year. As stated before most all users in the district use pumps or gravity systems to irrigate. I have not seen any measuring devices while doing inspections, so much is left to my observation while visiting these diversions. Jackson Creek has a few diversion that have not been looked at. The following is list of items that I performed for the year. This concludes the report by Marshall Wheatley.

### Items Performed

- researched water records for current owner.
- took phone calls pertaining to water right issues.
- visited courthouse for current owners.
- contacted owners about late assessments.
- visited diversion points, and made documentation.
- worked with Joyce on letters addressed to users about assessments both current, and late.
- visited , and resolved a couple of illegal water uses.
- reviewed temporary water permits for road construction.
