Meeting, March 21, 1979. District #47 G

Meeting held at R + R Cafe in Buhl,  
beginning at 9:00 a.m.

Members present: Robert Ring, Pat Elkin,  
Frank King, Ken Marshall, Gary Funderberg,  
& Ole Larsen (watermaster)

Robert Ring opened the meeting and served  
as chairman.

Gary Funderberg explained the program necessary  
to maintain the individual water rights and  
the system that could be used for measurement

financing and possibly a cost-sharing

A discussion was held as to the correctness of the water ~~license~~ license figures shown on the Frank King & Wes Reynolds (Farnsworth) figures. Gary Funderburg was going to check on this.

A motion was made by Pat Elkin that the 1979 budget be set at \$750 ~~plus~~ for 45 days plus \$20 per day after the day the water master ~~is~~ is called on to monitor the water deliveries. The \$20 per day figure also applies to unforeseen emergencies. The motion was seconded by Ken Marshall. It was passed by unanimous consent. It was agreed that \$290 <sup>(loss)</sup> carryover from 1978 would be split equally between Magic Water, Marshall & Wright.

Gary Funderburg suggested that assistant water masters be appointed to covered under Ole Person's bond so the individuals can measure their own water deliveries so that a permanent record be made on daily deliveries. The

Assistance water masters ~~to~~ appointed would be Herziger, King, Farnsworth, ~~S~~ King, Marshall, and Wright.

The waterusers of Water District No. 47-G met on March 22, 1976, at the law offices of Hepworth, Nungester, Felton & Hart, 1020 Main, Buhl, Idaho, at 10:00 a.m.

Mike Steele and Reid Newby of the Idaho Department of Water Resources were present.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Robert W. Ring, who announced a quorum was present of the waterusers.

The minutes of the previous meeting were ready by the secretary, Keith Munsee, and approved as read.

The president announced one purpose of the meeting was to discuss a gauging station. After a general discussion, Kenneth P. Elkin moved that a gauging station be installed at Balance Rock to measure the water of the in-flowing stream at that point on Salmon Falls Creek. The motion was seconded by Keith Munsee and upon being put to a vote, passed unanimously.

It was further moved by Kenneth P. Elkin that Keith Munsee, as secretary of the Water District, write to the State Director asking for the participation of the Department of Water Resources for installation and maintenance of the water measuring device, on a cost-sharing basis. The motion was seconded by Frank King and passed unanimously upon being put to a vote.

Kenneth P. Elkin then moved that the seven waterusers, to-wit, Magic Water Co., Keith Munsee, Herzingers, Robert W. Ring, Kenneth Marshall and Wesley Reynolds, at this time each pay \$100 to be put in a general fund to be used to pay any incurred expenses, other than the Watermaster's salary for the year 1976. The motion was seconded by Betty Herzinger and upon being put to a vote, the motion carried with a dissenting vote being cast by Keith Munsee.

Kenneth P. Elkin moved, since there was a likelihood of a water problem during the year 1976, that Magic Water Co., Kenneth Marshall, and Keith Munsee each pay \$250 for a two month period at the time the Watermaster is needed during the critical period. If the Watermaster's services are needed during this time by any of the other four users they will pay \$100 to Water District 47-G at the time the Watermaster is called. The Watermaster can make three or less trips to this user's diversion point. If Watermaster is called to

make a fourth trip by this user, the user has to pay an additional \$150 to Water District 47-G for the remaining portion of the year. Watermaster is to receive \$25.00 for each trip to this user's diversion and any money left to remain in Water District 47-G fund. The motion was seconded by Robert W. Ring and carried by a majority vote.

An amendment was presented by Kenneth Elkin and put in the form of a motion that any trips over the two required each 24 hour period during the critical water time to Magic Water Co., Kenneth Marshall or Keith Munsee diversion point are to be charged to the wateruser requesting said service and that this charge be worked out between the Watermaster and the wateruser requesting service. The motion was seconded by Keith Munsee and carried by unanimous vote.

All monies are to be handled by the County as to collection and disbursements, except extra trips to Magic Water, Kenneth Marshall or Keith Munsee which will be paid directly to the Watermaster. All claims are to be signed by both Watermaster and Secretary of the District except the Watermaster salary claim which would be honored with Watermaster signature only.

Watermaster shall check gauging station weekly during the irrigation season, March 15 to October 1. During short water time it will be checked daily. If this constitutes a special trip from his job or home he is to receive \$20.00 per trip. During the time the Marshall and Munsee diversion is checked each day, Watermaster is to check gauging station at no additional cost to Water District.

A general discussion followed concerning putting in weirs. Keith Munsee moved that all waterusers be required to put in a measuring device this spring. Mike Steele explained the value of the trapezoid flume. It was noted that Frank King had already installed this type of measuring device. Kenneth P. Elkin seconded the motion. Upon being put to a vote, the motion passed unanimously.

A discussion followed concerning the cost of a bond for the Water District Clear Lakes Agency was contacted to determine the cost of a \$10,000 bond, with the cost to be divided among the waterusers. This matter was tabled pending information concerning the type of bond and the cost.

Mike Steele presented record sheets which would show the amount of water delivered and where used, which could be used at any future date in the event of litigation.

After further discussion, it was determined the District should secure a surety bond and the cost, not to exceed \$50.00, be shared by all pumpers except Robert W. Ring. Kenneth P. Elkin seconded the motion and said motion passed unanimously upon being put to a vote.

Louise "Dle" Larsen was appointed Water-Master for 1982.

LITTLE SALMON FALLS WATER DIST. 47- G

BY\* LAWS

March 1, 1982

- I. Water users on the Salmon Falls Creek shall be entitled to one vote for each cubic foot per second of water delivered.
- II. Water-Master will be employed on an annual basis.
- III. Water-Master to deliver ~~ed~~ stored water.
- IV. All non-consumption water permits; power-permit, fish farming; shall not have a vote or be charged for the use of the water.
- V. An annual meeting of Water District 47-G to be legal you must have four members of a seven member committee, and the majority of the voting stock to be present.
- VI. A seven member Advisory Board will be elected annually by the water-users using their water right votes based on water delivered the previous year.

ANNUAL MEETING

MARCH 6, 1989

The annual meeting of Water District 476 was held at the Home Plate located in Buhl, Idaho at 7:00 p.m. Present were Pat Elkin, President, Dale Wright, Louis (Ole) E. Larsen, water master for the District during 1988, and Armand M. Eckert, Secretary.

It was moved and seconded that the same officers of the previous year hold the same offices during the 1989 irrigation season. The reading of the previous years minutes was waived and they were approved as submitted to the Department of Water Resources during 1988.

It was noted that billings were sent to the various water users and the Watermaster has been paid for the 1988 irrigation season. It was also moved and seconded that those who hadn't paid their bill for 1988, a one and one-half percent monthly interest rate would be charged on any unpaid balance from the date of the letter, if not paid within a reasonable time frame (e.g. 30 days).

It was decided to use Mr. Larsen as a Watermaster only on a retainer or "on call" basis, during the 1989 irrigation season. It was agreed that the pay rate would be at \$25 per call plus out-of-pocket expenses incurred by the Watermaster during the "call" period. However, it was also agreed that if it appeared that the Watermaster would be used for an extended period of time, in case of an emergency water shortage period, the District could hire Mr. Larsen on a monthly basis. His pay for any particular thirty days that he would be hired would be \$500. The \$25 fee would not be owed, if hired on this basis. Members of the District would decide, too, as to how many months Mr. Larsen would be hired full-time for (e.g. Possibly he would only be hired full time for one month, and then go back to being on a "call" basis).

It was also decided that the Water District would charge a maintenance fee for all water right holders. The list of water right holders would be obtained from Mr. Funderburg. The fee would be at \$0.50 per CFS (CUBIC FEET PER SECOND OF WATER) for each water right holder with minimum of a \$5.00 charge for each right held.




The Watermaster would also be paid 50% of this maintenance fee, whether or not he is "called" during the year. If hired for any particular 30-day period (monthly basis), he would not receive any of the maintenance fee.


Collection of any "call" fee plus any expenses will be made by the Secretary of the District from the person requesting the call. The District will reimburse the Watermaster immediately, whether or not the fee is collected. The same interest rate will also be charged as discussed above on any non-payments.

If the \$500 fee is used for any particular month, collection will be made from the District Water users by the Secretary. The Secretary will also be responsible for billing of the maintenance fee to all water right holders.

It was decided that the above items pertaining to hiring of the Watermaster, Louis E. Larsen, for the 1989 irrigation season, his fee and the collection thereof, the maintenance charge, interest rate, etc. would all be in a form of resolutions submitted to the Department of Water Resources with the current year budget. Such resolutions were passed by the majority present. There were no "no" votes. The period of time for the possible employment of the Water Master would run from April 15, 1989 to September 15, 1989.

The meeting was then adjourned at 7:30 p.m.

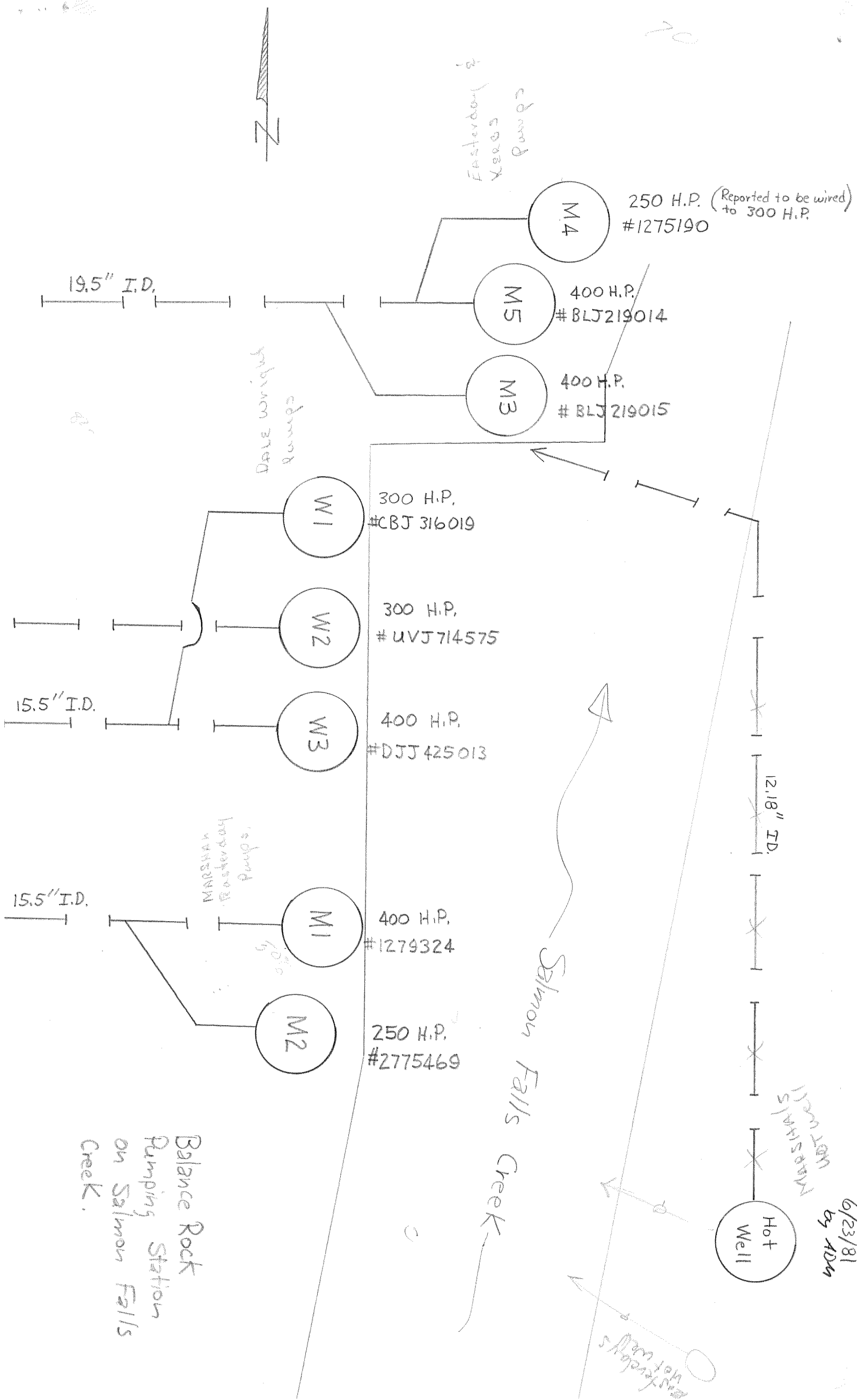
