The members reviewed minutes of last meeting and approved them as written, first motion, Carl Austin and second motion, Robert Whiteley.

It was voted to retain Kelly Adams as secretary/treasurer, first motion, Bud Bedke and second motion, Robert Whiteley. Note: Voting format was by majority of those present.

Members present approved the position of a water master but members present voted to filling the position until a later time. Members discussed the requirements of a water master, the authority and tasks required of this position.

Members approved the budget as stands and agreed that there was not a set budget.

The members then discussed the DEQ's TMDL studies and the results there of. Members have not seen the results and will request of the DEQ there findings. Also was discussed was the position of this water district within the Walcott WAG. Members assume the position to be a subcommittee under the Walcott Charter - unclear at this time.

For the 2002 irrigation season the outlook of the decreed water delivery will not be an issue. There is still approximately 12 inches of snow on the upper meadows of Goose Creek and below normal temperatures that are retaining snow melt.

Again, the members of Goose Creek water district 45-C adamantly request that IDWR list this district as being active and designate as such.
