Byron Martin moved to have a committee chedk into this guarantee and to take the necessary steps to get the repair work done. The motion was seconded by Don Mabey and it carried. Paul Kelly was to check with the S.C.S. tomorrow.

It was approved that the Watermaster should be able to draw his bond from the budget and also incidentals such as lumber, plastic, etc., with the approval of the Chairman and Secretary.

Bob Sagers, Association Accountant, explained the distribution of funds and payments for the Cottonwood Water Users Association of Lateral, Inc. A payment schedule was handed out to each water user.
