## Dear Brad:

Regarding our meeting on April 12, 2012 I have had an opportunity to review the proper procedures with the Idaho Department of Water Resources (IDWR) Western Region Office.

As we discussed, if you install a lockable lid on the gate valve at the Point of Diversion from Spring Valley Creek this will satisfy the requirement of a lockable control works. You will be required to install a weir or flow meter on the supply line for accurate measurement of the diversion. This weir can be installed anywhere on the pipeline as long as it is accessible to the Watermaster. For ease of operation, it may be installed where the pipe daylights at the pond. If you choose to install a flow meter, please review the requirements from IDWR. These requirements are available on line. I have included a copy for your use.

You will also be required to send a weekly report of diversion to my office. This report should reflect the total flow in cubic feet per second (cfs) each day during the week from Spring Valley Creek. This report will only pertain to water diverted from Spring Valley Creek.

Once these changes are in place, the requirements of your water right (63-5386) will be met.
