 - QA water measurement data & compare with water rights, coordinate with IDWR on water right database issues and cleanup

Elect IDWR as Watermaster

- 1 FTE from department assigned and appointed as watermaster for each district (2 FT E's total)
- Staffed in Eastern & Southern regional offices (& (Idaho Falls & Twin Falls)
- Supervision through regional manager and Water Distribution Section Manager
- Additional IDWR staff support SRBA/GIS, Measurement District, Clerical, Distribution
- Use regional office space, field equipm ent, PC's, vehicles etc.
