Enclosed please find a spreadsheet prepared by Chuck Brendecke of Hydrosphere, together with a compact disk containing supporting technical analysis and documentation of reach gain benefits attributable to implementation of the 2006 Replacement Water Plan ("2006 Plan") previously submitted by the North Snake and Magic Valley Ground Water Districts ("Districts") on May 30, 2006. The spreadsheet and supporting documentation contain revised numbers for reach gain benefits associated with the aquifer recharge component of the District's 2006 Plan. This revised analysis reflects the District's subsequent determination to implement this component using Wilson Lake, North Side Canal Company's main canal and four laterals and excluding recharge via any spill ponds as originally proposed. This revised approach was arrived at through consultation with North Side Canal Company, DEQ and IDWR personnel.

In all other respects, the Districts' 2006 Plan and documentation are unchanged.
