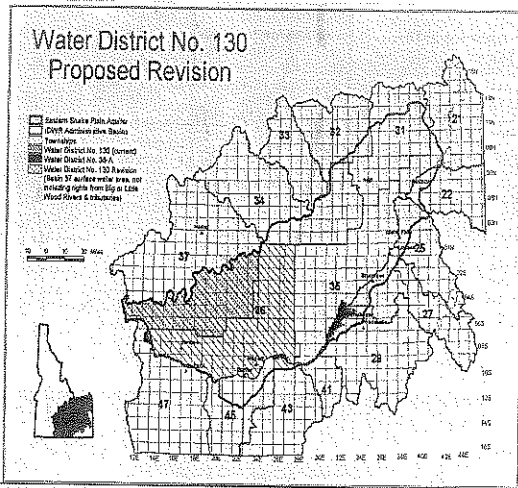

NOTICE OF HEARING AND PUBLIC MEETING IN THE MATTER OF RE-
VISING THE BOUNDARIES OF WATER DISTRICT NO. 130, THOU-
SAND SPRINGS AREA, WITHIN THE EASTERN SNAKE PLAIN
AQUIFER, IN ADMINISTRATIVE BASIN 37.

The Director of the Idaho Department of Water Resources ("Director") is
authorized to divide the state into water districts for the purpose of
distributing water among appropriators under the laws of the State of
Idaho. The authority to create water districts applies to those streams, or
other water sources including ground water, for which the priorities of
appropriation have been adjudicated by court decree. During a water
rights adjudication, Idaho Code § 42-1417 authorizes the district court to
approve interim administration of the rights by the Director if reasonably
necessary to protect senior rights. The district court may permit the
distribution of water pursuant to chapter 6, title 42, Idaho Code, in
accordance with partial decrees entered by the court or in accordance
with a Director's Report as may be modified by the court's order.
On December 13, 2005 the Snake River Basin Adjudication ("SRBA")
District Court issued an order authorizing the Director to distribute surface
water rights pursuant to chapter 6, title 42, Idaho Code, in accordance
with the Director's Reports and partial decrees that have superseded the
Director's Reports within Administrative Basin 37.

The Director now proposes to revise the boundaries of Water District No.
130, to include surface water rights in that portion of Basins 37 overlying
the Eastern Snake Plain Aquifer ("ESPA") as shown on the attached map.
The proposed action affects holders of surface water rights in the Thou-
sand Springs area in Basin 37 north of Hagerman, ID near the Malad
River and Bliss, ID. The Director does not propose to include in Water
District No. 130 surface water rights with sources from or tributary to the
Big Wood or Little Wood Rivers. Water rights from these sources are
currently administered by Water Districts No.s 37 and 37-M.

The purpose of the proposed action is to provide for the protection of
senior water rights within the affected area. Inclusion of these rights in
Water District 130 will allow the watermaster to administer these rights in
accordance with the prior appropriation doctrine as established by Idaho
law.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-604, that the
Director of the Department of Water Resources will conduct a public
hearing regarding the revision of the boundaries of the water district as
follows:

PUBLIC HEARING FOR REVISION OF THE BOUNDARIES
OF THE WATER DISTRICT:

7:00 pm, January 26, 2006, at the American Legion Hall Post 31,
281 North State Street (Highway 30), Hagerman, ID

Information and testimony presented at the hearing on January 26, 2006,
will create a record upon which the Director will rely to determine whether
revision of the boundaries of the water district is appropriate. Persons at-
tending the hearing will be provided an opportunity to provide oral testimo-
ny regarding the revision of the district boundaries. Written comments
may also be submitted to the Director at the hearing or at any time prior to
the close of the written comment period on February 6, 2006. Written
comments not presented at the hearing can be sent to the Director to be
received at the Department of Water Resources, P. O. Box 83720, Boise,
Idaho, 83720-0098, no later than February 6, 2006.

The Director proposes that all surface water rights with points of diversion
located within the revised boundaries be included in the Water District No.
130, except those used solely for domestic and/or stock water purposes
and those surface water rights currently diverted from or tributary to the
Big Wood and Little Wood Rivers. This notice of hearing has been sent to
all water right holders of record in accordance with these criteria.

The hearing will be conducted in a facility that meets the accessibility
requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act. Should you require
special accommodations in order to attend, participate in, or understand
the hearing, please contact the Department of Water Resources at least
